- 1. The size of the note is  $100 \text{mm} \times 60 \text{mm}$  and is signed by the Finance Secretary;
- 2. This note is printed on highly durable paper containing synthetic fibre;
- 3. This note contains the following watermarks:
  - The Portrait of Bangabandhu Sheikh Muzibur Rahman, the Father of the Nation;
  - Numeral '2' as very bright electrotype watermark just below the portrait;
  - Electrotype watermark of the logo of the People's Republic of Bangladesh on the left side of the portrait which is brighter than the portrait.
- 4. The note has a 2mm security thread on the left which is embedded inside the note and can be seen from both sides when seen against the light;
- 5. There are repeated microprints of the text 'BANGLADESH' inside the vertical pattern on the left to the portrait which can only be seen with magnifying glass.
- 6. The front left-side of the note contains the portrait of Bangabandhu Sheikh Muzibur Rahman, the Father of the Nation. The picture of National Monument is printed in light color in the middle of the front side of the note.
- 7. The sketch of the Memorial Monument for the Language Martyrs is printed on the back side of the note.
